Our Canteen

Do you love a rink burger on a cold December morning? We do too! But those burgers aren't going to cook themselves! Our Maroon kitchen can't run without YOU. Each year your family will be assigned shifts to work at the canteen. If you are unable to work, please ensure you find your own replacement for that shift. Please be kind when asked to work your shift, be sure to show up! The canteen profits over \$30,000 a season and that money goes toward keeping our rink in tip top shape!

Skate Sharpening

Did you know you should have your skates sharpened every 8-10 hours of use on an indoor rink and every 6-7 hours when used on an outdoor rink? Did you know our rink has an in-house skate sharpener and a designated person to use it? Did you know the Strasbourg Rink was built in 1976, well that part isn't important.

Prices for Skate Sharpening: \$8/ a pair OR \$70 for a punch card of 10 sharpens

There will be a posted phone number posted outside the skate sharpening office, along with throughout the rink.

GAME DAY EXPECTATIONS

There isn't anything better than a barn burner in our hometown! But to make sure every game runs as smooth as our ice surface, we need your help! There are several jobs to be completed at every home game and your manager will assign your jobs!

Admission Collector

Must be a minimum of 18 years of age. 15 years of age may assist.

Admission for all minor hockey games:

Adults\$5.00

Students 17 & under ... \$3.00

Children 12 & Under ... Free

Admission for Provincial Playoff games is as follows:

Adults\$7.00

Students 17 & under \$5.00

Scorekeeper/Timekeeper

- a. Pick up frozen puck(s) from the penalty box freezer before the game.
- b. Replace with fresh picks each period.
- c. Ensure the scoreboard is set up.
- d. Return the pucks to the freezer after the game.
- e. After the ice has been flooded, ensure nets are set in the proper place.

50/50 Seller

- a. Pick up tickets and bucket from the office.
- b. Tickets are sold 10 for \$5.00, 30 for \$10.00.
- c. Draw the winning ticket about 10 minutes into the third period and have the announcer announce the winning ticket number.
- d. Half of the proceeds are given to the winner.
- e. The remaining half of the proceeds is given to the SMHA treasurer.
